Baptised Catholic children in Year Three will receive the <u>Sacrament of</u> <u>Reconciliation (First Confession) on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> March 2025 at 6pm</u> <u>at St Joseph's Church.</u>

Baptised Catholic children in Year Four who have already received the Sacrament of Reconciliation, will make their <u>First Holy Communion on</u> <u>Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> June 2025 at 11.00am</u>.

Baptised Catholic children in Year Six who have already made their First Holy Communion will receive the <u>Sacrament of Confirmation on</u> <u>Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> March 2025 at 7.00pm.</u>

Parents of baptised Catholic children in Y3 should have received a letter explaining the preparation for the Sacrament of Reconciliation which began today. This letter has also been sent to parents of baptised Catholic children in Y4 – Y6 who have not yet received the Sacrament of Reconciliation. They are very welcome to join the preparation and receive the sacraments this year. If you have not received the letter and your child is a baptised Catholic, please contact a member of staff.

If your child is not a baptised Catholic but wishes to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and Confirmation, you will need to speak with Fr Julian. Details of when and how to do this can be found on the parish newsletter on the parish website.
